Here are my Week 4 Bets.

Browns at Vikings

Details

Cleveland -2 Total: 51½

Browns -120 | Vikes +100

Starting the day off going against the public steam on Minnesota.

I like how Minnesota has played this year and Kirk Cousins has certainly played well. The thing is... Cleveland is on a different level than Minny's previous opponents.

The Browns defense is a better unit than the Vikings offense. I suspect Cousins will have his biggest test of the season.

The Browns rushing attack will be the deciding factor today. They match up favorably against the Vikings front seven, who have allowed plenty of yards on 1st and 2nd downs.

Stefanski has a lot of guts and he is capable of putting together a surprising game-plan in big situations. This is his return to Minnesota and I'm sure the Browns view this as an important game.

I know the Vikings are a popular pick this week, but I view Cleveland as the much better team with no reason to overlook this game.

The Pick: Browns -2

Ravens at Broncos

Details

Ravens -1

Total: 441/2

Broncos -105 | Ravens -115

Now look... The Broncos have run up a 3-0 record against the 3 worst teams in the league - Giants, Jets, and Jags. But don't make the mistake of completely discounting those wins. Their defense has been great and earned all of those wins.

The Ravens are getting some players back from injury this week, but they are still beat up. So far the replacements have stepped up, but backups regress steadily as they are exposed to more scrutiny.

Let's not forget they literally won by an inch last week against Detroit. Now they travel to Denver, where teams often struggle early in the season. I love Harbaugh and Jackson, but this is a tough spot for them.

The Pick: Broncos +1

Steelers at Packers

Packers -61/2 Total: 451/2

Packers -280 | Steelers +230

My first 2 unit bet of the season is the Packers to cover.

We hear a lot about the Steeler defense, which gets Watt back this week, but I don't think they match up well against the Packers. Rodgers and his O-line won't have much of a problem with the pass rush. The Steeler secondary has some solid players, but they've got some holes too.

In fact, I think the Packers defense will be a much bigger issue for the Steelers. Pittsburgh offensive line is... bad. Rashan Gary along with Preston Smith and Kenny Clark are going to cause problems every time Big Ben needs to pick up a third down or try sneaking in a backdoor cover.

Ben R has also been terrible, he's ranked near the bottom of NFL below Zach Wilson and Matt Ryan. To make matters worse, Claypool will be out this week.

I respect Tomlin as a coach, but in today's NFL your QB needs to outplay, or at least be close, your opponent. It's hard to imagine Roethlisberger competing with Rodgers right now.

I've got the Packer's power ranked significantly higher then Pittsburgh. That doesn't guarantee a win, but it does indicate a win probability near 80%. With a decent chance of a route.

The Pick: Packers -6½ (2 units)
